What Personal Data do we Collect and Store?

Breadgate International, FTM-Mission Skandinavien collects and stores personal data from people that receives or want to receive information about the foundation's work. This includes donations (amount) addresses, telephone numbers, comments and email addresses. In connection with the donor function AutoGiro we store the Social Security number of Swedish residents.

Purpose for Collecting and Storing Personal Data

The purpose for collecting personal data is for use when communicating with individuals that receive information about the foundation's work. This is mainly done through monthly newsletters or through social media such as Facebook or on the website.

Consent

Collection of personal data is done through consent. This is done using various methods, such as e-mail, visits to local churches, or organizations to inform about the foundations work. Communication is also done through user forms available on our website or on social media, such as Facebook.

Rights of the Data Subject

The donor or recipient of information has the right to know what personal data is collected and stored. The donor/recipient has, upon request, the right to have their personal data erased permanently at any given time.

How We Use the Information

Breadgate International, FTM-Mission Skandinavien will never sell, exchange, rent out or spread personal data (unless they have been given for official/public use) such as email addresses, addresses or telephone numbers of the donor/recipient. Breadgate International, FTM-Mission Skandinavien will only use the personal data for the following purposes:

- Give a receipt to the donor, if asked for
- Thank the donor for her donation
- Inform the donor/recipient about upcoming projects and other activities.
- Internal analysis and registration
- Contact the donor/recipient about changes in this policy.

We Respect the Donor

Breadgate International, FTM-Mission Scandinavia's work, is solely dependent on donations from donors that through their commitment and expressed will, wishes to support the foundation and its work. All donors are of importance to the foundation and they are the basis for the continued work of the foundation. It's not the size of the gift that is crucial to us, all gifts, regardless of size, is of importance for the foundation's work.

The donor should be reassured that collected funds are used for the purpose for which they initially were collected, so-called "earmarked funds". In the Foundation's newsletter for Scandinavia, on the donor slip, the donor can choose if the donation should be earmarked for a specific cause. Otherwise, the donor hands over to the foundation to decide how the

gift should be used and where it “is best needed” as stated on the payment slip. Likewise, if the donor wishes to give anonymously, this must be respected. The donor can actively choose if it wishes to receive a letter of reply/thank you letter for the donation given, by ticking the box on the payment card. The above applies only for donors living in Scandinavia (BankGiro).

Financial Information

Breadgate International, FTM-Mission Skandinavien receives its donations mostly through monthly donations, letters of donation, PayPal and Swish (Swish applies to Swedish donors only). Donations are, to some extent, also received through private celebrations and birthdays, memorials, wills and the donors’ private fundraising and/or initiatives. All access to the donor’s financial information is limited to professional staff that must process these tasks. No such information is given to any person, organization or group that does not need access to this data. The Foundation uses only online services whose payment management is considered secure in terms of security and good reputation.

Clearing out Personal Data

Routines concerning deleting personal data is displayed below in the chart. These are the databases and software that the Foundation uses and that contains personal data.

Cookie Files

A cookie is a small text-based data file that a web server may be saving in the site visitor’s computer. Through the fact that cookies are generally returned with each request to that page, it is possible for the server to keep track of the visitor’s preferences. According to (SFS 2003: 389), anyone who visits a website should be informed about what cookies are used to and are given the opportunity to refuse such use. If you do not want to accept cookies, your browser may be set so you automatically refuse cookies storage or inform each time someone wants to get a cookie. Through the browser, previously stored cookies can also be deleted. See the browser’s help pages for more information.
